#### Medication

Today we have sent home a blank medication permission and instruction form in a zip lock bag. Please ensure any medication your child may need is listed on this form, along with dosage and timing. Place medication form, along with medication, in zip lock bag and return to the office during week 4 (*Monday 1st – Friday 5th November*). Please ensure that any dietary requirements (even those already stated) are noted on this form. Place the medication, along with this form into the zip lock bag.

Please note that we are not able to supply medication to students unless the form is completed. This includes paracetamol and hayfever medication. All personal medication must be packed in the zip lock bag with the form. A medical log will be kept of all medication administered.

Students with asthma listed on their medical form *must carry a Ventolin at all times*. Please do not pack medication into your child's suitcase it needs to be in the backpack which they carry.

All forms need to be read, signed and returned regardless of medication requirements.

# Important departure information – Monday 8<sup>th</sup> November
